

East Lawn Food Pantry.


Wow, here we are actually in the new trailer allowing patrons to select their own items! Patrons are to bring their own bags to shop and depending upon the health guidelines, masks may or may not be required. There are still items to be addressed at the pantry but we are at least in our own place. Much thanks to the church Ad Council for their support of allowing the pantry to operate out of the church Fellowship Hall during the transition.

Our first goal is to have the food area set up for stocking shelves of items and seeing how the flow of patrons operates before we set up the clothing area which will be in the same area as the food but yet separate from the food area. The rear of the trailer will be used for cold storage of food, preparation of items and sanitation of items used at the pantry.

Thank You to all those volunteers who pick food items up from the grocery stores in Kearney and transport it to the trailer, to volunteers that sort the food items and place it on the shelves, to volunteers that work each day the pantry and to those that work on those days repacking items or other large packaged items into smaller packages for distribution, and to those cleaning the pantry area. If you would like to help with one of these or more areas, please contact Colleen at the number listed below.

Volunteer hours account for 700 to 800 hours each month. Thank You All!! Remember that this is your mission and if you can furnish your time once a month, it would be great. Most volunteers have had their second COVID shot and that is a step in the right direction. Congrats to you! Number of families being served has gone down somewhat as compared to earlier months, but still serve over 400 families each month. Our outreach to Countryside Trailer Court will end when the USDA program ends which will be the end of May. Those families will need to come to East Lawn for help.
